



I could focus on everything else that was going on and I didn't have to worry about these little tiny details that you guys had thought of already for me.





## Our Volunteers



Our volunteers have always stepped up and given way beyond what we would hope, but this year with all the changes and crises, they inspired us by how they continued to care for our families way beyond just gatherings.

In March when the shelter-in-place began we had to pause our 'gathering days' due to safety. We started shipping furniture and essentials directly to families. A board member called the families we had helped over the past few years to find out how we could support them. Our amazing volunteers began picking up and delivering food boxes and other emergency needs like cleaning supplies to the families who were in crisis. Some volunteers connected with families and dropped off activities for the kids and other helpful items. One volunteer created and ran a virtual arts & craft camp for the kids who were homebound, utilizing local high school students as the "Camp Counselors."

By summer we created a hybrid version of our "gathering day". We combined some direct deliveries with collecting smaller furnishings and home items from donors at a safe drop-off spot. We then had a very small team of volunteers meet at the family's home to set up and organize the home, following new safety protocols.

#### From the bottom of our hearts, thank you! Thank you for helping our Grateful Gathering families even as each of you was also dealing with the impact of the pandemic in your own families.

We will never forget how quickly you all came to us when the shelter in place began asking, "What about our families? What can we do to help them?". YOU are the reason we were able to make the difference we did in 2020.
